2010 Airspeed Aviation Pilot Scholarship

In celebration of the opening of our new pilot training facility in Singleton, Airspeed Aviation is pleased to invite applications for our two Pilot Scholarships valued at \$1000 each. One scholarship will be awarded to an aspiring pilot from the Scone/ Muswellbrook area, and the other will be awarded to an aspiring pilot in the Singleton area.

The money is to be used to establish a career as a Commercial Pilot. \$500 will be allocated into the successful applicants training fund upon being awarded the scholarship and the remaining \$500 will be allocated into their training fund upon starting navigation training.

Applications for the Airspeed Aviation Pilots Scholarship for 2010 is open to any Australian Citizen between 16 and 25 years of age who aspires to become a commercial pilot.

The selection process will involve two stages.

Stage 1

For the first stage you are required to fill out the attached Application Form and submit it by mail to the below address to ensure receipt by the 10th of September 2010. You may attach any additional or special information that you feel may support your application, including copies of any references or special awards, your Curriculum Vitae, school reports or certificates.

The top applicants will be contacted via phone by 5pm on the 10th of September 2010 to advise them of their success at this stage and to schedule stage 2.

Stage 2

The second stage involves undertaking a Trial Introduction Flight to allow us to assess your ability to learn and to handle an aircraft. This will involve a short theory lesson and a 30-minute flight followed by some questions to assess the knowledge you have gained. There will be a \$90.00 fee for this stage.

Applicants will be contacted by the 1st of October 2010 to notify them of their result and to inform the winners of their success in obtaining a scholarship.
